On the Main Findings of the Survey on the Perception of the Owners/Managers of the Economic Establishments Towards the Economic Conditions, April 2004

The situation of 43.4% of the establishments is worse in April 2004 compared with march 2004. About 32.5% expected a worse situation in the coming month

PCBS conducted the seventh round of the survey on the perception of the owners/managers of the economic establishments about the economic conditions. Data collection took place during the period 1/4/2004-19/4/2004 on a sample composed of 570 establishments, of which 381 in West Bank and 189 in Gaza Strip.

The Current Situation:

About 43.4% of the owners/managers of the economic establishments in the Palestinian Territory reported that their current economic situation is worse compared with last month (43.5% in West Bank and 43.0% in Gaza Strip), against 16.2% reported better situation (18.8% in West Bank and 10.4% in Gaza strip).

Concerning restriction on mobility, 62.2% of the owners/managers of the economic establishments reported that there was no real difficulties in reaching the place of work in the past month, while this percent was 54.9% in the past six month, and 10.7% reported that it was difficult for workers to reach place of work in the past month while this percent was 14.4% in the past six months. There was significant differences between the perceptions in West Bank and Gaza Strip, as 87.5% of them in Gaza Strip reported that there were no difficulties in reaching the place of work in the past month, this percent was 88.1% for the past six months, as for West Bank; 51.2% reported that there were no difficulties in the past month and 40.4% for the past six months.

Short Term Expectations:

As for the expectation in the short term (in the coming month), 25.3% of the owners/managers of the economic establishments expect a better situation for their establishment compared with today (29.7% in West Bank and 15.3% in Gaza Strip), against 32.5% expected a worse situation (34.8% in West Bank and 27.0% in Gaza Strip), while 42.2% expected no changes (35.5% in West Bank and 57.7% in Gaza Strip).

The main findings of the survey regarding the level of employment show some pessimism, as 21.1% expected decline in employment level, while 10.3% expected an increase, and 68.6% expect the same level.

In expecting the sales volume, 15.5% of the owners/managers of the economic establishments in the Palestinian Territory expect higher sales volume, and 29.0% expect lower sales volume.

Mid-Term Expectations:

The expectations of the owners/managers of the economic establishments in Gaza Strip were optimistic, 20.4% expected decline in employment level, while 32.4% expected increasing, and 47.2% expected the same level. In West Bank, people were pessimistic as 15.2% expected increasing employment level and 62.0% expected the same level, and 22.8% expected decreasing.

Data reveal that 28.7% of the owners/managers of the economic establishments reported that the sales volume will decrease in the coming six months (26.5% in West Bank, and 33.8% in Gaza Strip), while 25.1% of them expect an increase in sales Volume (20.3% in West Bank and 36.0% in Gaza Strip).

Level of Direct Investment:

The main findings of the survey show that there may be no changes on the level of direct investments in the coming period in general, as 76.3% of the respondents expect that there will be no changes in this field in the coming year, and 10.4% expect an increase in the level of direct investment in the coming year, and 13.3% expect decrease.

The owners/managers of the economic establishments expect that the main reason for the expected investment level to decline or remain constant will be the limited business prospects 49.6%, while 3.6% of respondents said it will be the lack of credit/finance, and 46.8% for both cases.

Problems and obstacles facing the establishments:

The owners/managers of the economic establishments reported facing major problems in their work as a result of the Israeli measures, some of them were suffering from financial problems (47.6% of the respondents), others had problems on obtaining raw materials and inputs (27.6%), and problems on shipping goods and marketing (25.4%), while 20.4% had problems related to the ability of laboures to reach place of work. In addition 7.0% of the owners/managers indicated that they were unable to operate regulary because of curefew, and 26.1% from other problems.
